The Community Food Bank serves the food security needs of many Southern Arizonans, but we do so much more. Our programs range from education and advocacy –workshops, ecological restoration, starter plants, composting, etc. - to helping families set up household and community gardens, and coordinating farmers' markets.

Here is a snapshot of their many programs and services

- TEFAP (The Emergency Food Assistance Program) provides low-income individuals and households with surplus commodities donated by the USDA. The Community Food Bank of Southern Arizona, with assistance from volunteers, combines donated items, purchased food, and USDA commodities to create a food box to supplement food needs.
- A program of the Community Food Bank, "Caridad", Spanish for "charity", this program has touched the lives of countless people for more than 15 years. A 10-week culinary training program for unemployed and underemployed individuals, and a full catering service, Caridad is built on the principle that hunger in our community can be solved in many ways.
